## Suggested Home Study Activities—Phase 3

Create a quiz Ask a parent or carer to ask you 10 questions about a topic.	Pictionary Draw a picture to show your knowledge.	Mindmap Create a diagram with facts.	Paperchain Make a paper chain with facts written on each chain.
<u>Song/rap</u> Create a song or rap about a topic.	<u>A-Z</u> Think of a word for each letter of the alphabet relat- ed to the topic.	Bunting Create bunting with facts on.	Flashcards Write out flashcards and ask someone to quiz you.
Mnemonics Example: My Very Easy Method Just Speeds Up Naming Planets To help remember the planets.	Poster Design an eye-catching poster full of facts.	PowerPoint Make a PowerPoint on a topic.	<b>iMorie</b> Make a short film about a topic.
<b>Record</b> Record yourself say- ing facts.	<b>Blanks</b> Fill in a paragraph with missing words.	<u>Summary</u> <u>Booklet</u> Make a booklet of facts.	<u>Timeline</u> Make a timeline of a history topic.
Rapidough Make something related to your topic with playdough.	<u>Story</u> Make a story using vital vocabulary.	Wordsearch Make a wordsearch using vital vocabu- lary/spellings and ask an adult to find them.	Create clues for vital vocabulary/ spellings.
