# <u>Autumn I Learning Menu</u>

This half-term in Year 2 we are learning:

### English:

Our book this half-term is 'Jack and the Baked Beanstalk', by Colin Stimpson. We will be using this text to inspire the following:

A persuasive leaflet.

A detailed, first-hand eyewitness report.

A traditional tale/fantasy adventure.

A further twist of Jack and the Baked Beanstalk - Jack and the 'Jellybean Stalk' (containing a sweet shop, as opposed to a café).

Alongside this, we will be reading lots of books as a class, developing our comprehension skills through whole class reading sessions and completing daily RWI (Phonics) lessons.

#### Maths

In Maths, we are learning about the concept of place value (tens and ones) and beginning column addition/subtraction with 2-digit numbers. In Year 2, we look at the numbers up to 100.

Alongside this, the children will be exploring the concept of Picture Graphs and 2D Shapes.

Times Tables focus: 10 Times Table.

Please continue to engage with **Times Tables Rock.Stars** and **Daily 10** (Top Marks) at home.

Each day, the children will be practicing their counting and arithmetic skills during retrieval time.

### Geography:

Our topic is called 'Putting St Helens on the Map'. Our Learning Quests within lessons will enable us to explore the following:

LQI: Where is St. Helens located?
LQ2: What are the human and physical features of St.
Helens?
LQ3: What landmarks could a visitor to St. Helens visit?
LQ4: What does the centre of St. Helens look like on an aerial photograph?
LQ5: Does all of St. Helens look the same?
LQ6: Which route do we take from Parish CE Primary School to the field?
