This half-term in Year 5 we are learning:

English:	Maths:	Geography:
In English, we are reading Anglo-Saxon Boy with cross-curricular links to our History unit. We will be writing a persuasive speech, a character diary entry and instructions. This will deepen our understanding of our History unit completed in Autumn 1.	We are learning about multiplication and division, alongside deepening our understanding through completion of word problems including, use of bar models.
