Autumn I Learning Menu

This half-term in Year 3 we are learning:

English:

Our book this half-term is The True Story of the Three Little Pigs, by Jon Scieseka. We will be using this text to inspire the following:

- A detailed character description of Alexander T. Wolf.
- A persuasive speech, to encourage the public to believe that Alexander T. Wolf is/is not guilty.
- A newspaper report

Alongside this, we will be reading lots of books as a class and we will start our daily reading with the classic 'Iron Man', by Ted Hughes.

Each day, we will be continuing to revise Set 2 and 3 Phonics sounds, Year 3 Spellings and cursive/joined handwriting. Please continue to access Spelling Frame and Mrs. Suthers Phonics videos on You Tube, to assist with this.

Maths:

In Maths, we are learning about the concept of place value (hundreds, tens and ones) and beginning column addition/subtraction with 3-digit numbers and renaming. In Year 3, we look at the numbers up to 1000.

The children should already be fluent in their 2's, 5's and 10 times tables. This half-term, we will begin looking at how to count in 4's and 8's, alongside counting in 10's, 50's and 100's - fram any given number. Please continue to engage with Times Tables Rock Stars and Daily 10 (Top marks) at home, to assist with this.

Each day, the children will be practicing their **counting** and **arithmetic** skills too.
