Fees and Funding

We are open term time over 38 weeks. We offer funded and paid sessions or a combination of both to suit your childcare requirements, along with the option of splitting your funding with another childcare provider to secure year round care. We can work with you to ensure that you maximise the use of your funding available to best suit your needs. You can opt for as much or as little as you wish. Please see our offer below.

Session fees are payable in all cases of non-attendance. We are unable to swap sessions, however, additional sessions can be booked if we can accommodate your requirements. We ask that any adjustments to hours are requested in writing a term in advance.

Healthy snacks are provided for 60p per day. Children who are staying all day can either bring a packed lunch or purchase a school meal at the cost of £3.72. Sometimes we offer extra activities to our Nursery children. We make no charge for these enrichment activities but do ask for voluntary contributions towards the cost.

Intakes

We have three intakes across the academic year – September, January and April, although you are more than welcome to discuss joining our nursery during one of our terms.
