#### **Staff Training**

**Each week, we'll share the training our staff have taken part in to help them better support the children and grow as experts in their field.**

Mrs Evans, Mrs Frank and Mrs Willson attended the New Writing Framework training session on Tuesday morning while Mr Christmas and Mrs White attended on Tuesday afternoon. The training was on investigating sentence development and writing mastery with a focus on how oracy supports sentence construction as well as the Gradual Release of Responsibility model with particular attention on how feedback is used to enhance progress in writing.

Mrs Willson attended a Geography lead training session which looked at the new emphasis on substantive and disciplinary knowledge in Ofsted's Education Inspection framework as well as the National Curriculum requirements in KS1 and KS2, building upon the geography taught in Early Years, in line with the 2021 Development Matters guidance and the current need to think of progression from Early Years to Year 6.

Mrs Haslam hosted the ELSA supervision session on Wednesday afternoon which provides a confidential, reflective space to process challenging cases, gain extra training, and maintain accreditation for the vital role they play in schools.
