A reminder from Severn Trent:

- Access for parents via Rake Lane will be maintained during the following times: **08:15–08:45** and **15:00–15:30**. Passes issued to identify vehicles accessing the road specifically for Eccleston C of E Primary School, ensuring this access is limited to school traffic only. Permits to be placed on the vehicles dash boards will be delivered to the school today.
- It is **strongly recommended** that Rake Lane is used for access to the school, with vehicles then continuing onto the Eaton Road diversion route. This will help minimise vehicle queuing, particularly as there will be excavations and site operatives present. This is especially important at the start of the Rake Lane project, when works will temporarily block one lane of the Rake Lane junction onto Wrexham Road.
- As this is classed a construction site, we request that the speed limit is **20mph**, and vehicles passing work areas should pass at **10mph**, with drivers proceeding with caution through the closure and being mindful of local farmers, who may be accessing frontages on Rake Lane with articulated vehicles, and that access is granted during the above mentioned timeslot on the

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understanding that all driving within the authorised area is undertaken entirely at the drivers' own risk.

- **Please note that if we feel that road users are making it unsafe for themselves or the workforce we will have no option but to enforce a hard closure for the duration.**

Just a reminder that due to allergies we are a NO NUTs school. This includes all types of tree and **ground nuts as well as sesame seeds**. If your child accidentally brings in a product containing nuts, we will keep it safe and give it back to you at the end of the day. We will offer them a school snack as an alternative for that day.
