



Should I keep my child off school?



Yes, until....

- **Chicken Pox** — Until all blisters have crusted over
- **Vomiting and Diarrhoea** — Return 48 hours from the last episode
- **Flu-like temperature** — Until they no longer have a high temperature
- **Impetigo** — Until their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
- **Measles** — 4 days after the rash first appeared
- **Mumps** — 5 days after the swelling started
- **Scabies** — Until they've had their first treatment
- **Scarlet Fever** — 24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
- **Whooping Cough** — 48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

No, but inform school of:

- Cold
- Cough
- Sore throat / Tonsillitis (keep off school if accompanied by a high temperature)
- Earache
- Head lice
- Hand, foot and mouth
- Threadworms
- Glandular Fever
- Slapped Cheek
- Conjunctivitis
- Cold sores
