We are hoping to go to Chester next term when we study the Romans

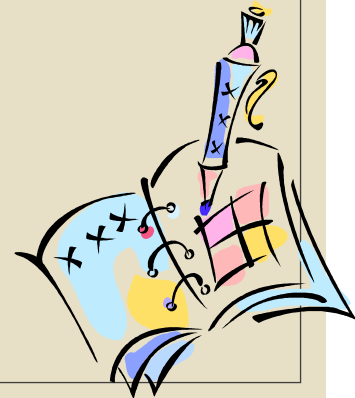
Petty Pool is booked for April/May time.
