This Week...

The children loving our phonics lessons and all the activities they've taken part in linked to the phonemes: 't and p'.

Children have been

- making **t**ea in water play
- making pictures with the '**t**ap **t**ap' shapes
- **p**laying with **p**enne **p**asta
- making a '**p**' in **p**lay dough

We've been practising blending the sounds to read words too!



In Tuesday's PE lesson, the children were learning to follow instructions, move around the hall safely and throwing bean bags in hoops whilst working as a team.

Next Week...

We will learn two new phonic sounds; '**i** and **n**'. The children will take part in daily Gross Motor and Fine Motor Skills to build up the muscle control in readiness for writing – Dough Disco has been very popular this week!
