In Phonics the children learned 'd' and 'g'. Children have been

- using **d**ance scarves in PE
- playing with the **d**inosaurs
- using tongs to pick up and move pom poms onto the **g**host

We have been exploring *musical mind mapping* – using music and movement to spark creativity and expression. The children loved using **dance scarves** to show how the music made them feel, creating beautiful swirls, waves, and patterns in the air. It was wonderful to see their imaginations come to life!
