Byley Busy Buddies: Just a reminder that we run great Breakfast and After School Clubs every day - at very reasonable rates!

The times and costs are:

Breakfast Club: Monday - Friday 7:45 until start of school - £5.00 (£3.50 per sibling)

After School Club - Monday - Friday end of school until 4:15pm (no snack) £4.50

Monday - Thursday full session until 5:30 £9.50 (8.00 per sibling)

Reading: please continue to encourage your child to read at home. Every Monday morning, children's reading diaries are taken in. If a child has read 3 or 4 times in the week, they get 1 spot on their chart. If they have read 5 times or more, they get 2 spots. Once they reach 20 spots, they will receive a certificate in our Friday Celebration Assembly. Reading regularly - or being read to - very much supports children with developing their understanding, confidence, reading fluency and writing. Well done to the children receiving their Bronze awards today.
