A message from Miss Whittingham: this week seems to have gone quite quickly. I attended a meeting about children's writing on Tuesday. We looked at the Government's new writing framework. I also had the great opportunity to observe a lesson in another school as well as look at books from other schools - it made me even prouder of the work we do at Byley.

STEM Skill Clubs: these are returning to the **Grange School Sports Centre in Hartford** this half-term for children aged 8-13. REMINDERS:

- **Pick up:** if you wait outside school for your child (mainly parents/carers of Year 6 children), please can you remind them to walk close to the fence as they come to meet you. We have had a couple of incidences recently where children haven't been able to get passed cars and have gone round on to the road.
- **With the above point in mind, please can I ask that you remain mindful when parking. I know it can be tricky, particularly at pick up, but please do be aware of children and families walking back to cars, crossing the road etc.**
- **Parking:** please do not park in the staff car park. There is not a great deal of room and staff are also arriving and leaving throughout the day.
