Fine Motor: Exploring with playdough to make bug/minibeasts fossils. Playdough jungle, lollipop sticks, stones, animal habitats, feathers. Wrapping up parcels for the Dear Zoo animals + label them. Superworm sensory tray, save the minibeasts using different tools

Gross Motor: Dear Zoo animals footprint cards—hop challenge. Animals washing, sponges, brushes, leaves, feathers. Catching an object with one hand thrown by the teacher. Throw 2 beanbags at the same time. Throw beanbags at a target. Throw whilst sitting, kneeling and standing at a target.
