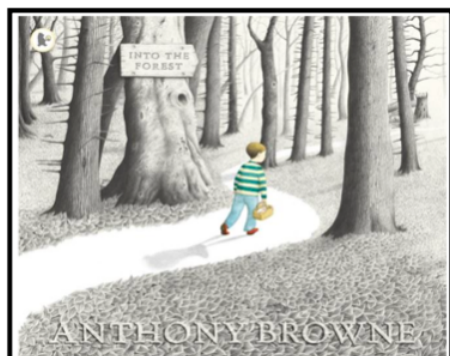




## Year 3: Into The Forest

### Vocabulary

huddling	holding your arms close to your body
terrified	feeling extreme fear
inhaling	breathing in
alien	something that is strange, possibly scary
lurched	make a sudden, uncontrolled movement
eerie	something strange; makes you feel nervous
ensconced	settled in a comfortable place, without moving
flattering	giving praise and saying nice things
bustled	moving somewhere in a hurried way
forbidden	not allowed to do it or have it
thronged	be or go somewhere in large numbers
clutch	holding something very tightly
halted	coming to a complete stop

### Grammar, Punctuation and Language Features

personification	giving a non-human object human characteristics (emotions, feelings, sensations, movement)	lightning <b>screams</b> into the darkness trees <b>waved</b> their branches
adverbial phrase	tell us how, when, where or why the verb is happening	<b>when, if, that, but, because, and, so, while</b>
inverted commas (" ")	go before and after direct speech, surrounding what was said; punctuation (? . ! , ) goes inside the inverted commas	"What's for tea?" he asked. She exclaimed, "I love it!"
pronouns	replaces a noun to avoid repetition ( <b>I, me, my, you, he, she, they, them, it</b> )	Tom ran into the forest and <b>he</b> gazed at the trees.
prefix	added to the beginning of a word to create a new word	familiar - <b>un</b> familiar clockwise - <b>anti</b> clockwise
determiner (articles)	a word that goes before a noun and identifies the noun in more detail	<b>a</b> tree; <b>an</b> apple; <b>the</b> forest (a = consonant; an = vowel)
apostrophe for possession	singular noun - add ' and s plural noun ending in s - add '	the cliff's edge the eyes' sockets

### Focus Writing

Lost narrative	A story where a character is lost in an unknown, often mystical place or location and must find their way home.
News report	A formal type of writing, designed to give people information about what is happening in the local area or world.
