



Year 4: Money Matters

Key Vocabulary

Salary	A fixed amount of money paid at regular times for the work a person has done.
Wages	Money paid in a regular way to a person for doing work or giving help.
Job	A particular task or piece of work.
Money	The coins or paper notes of a country used to buy things or pay for services.
Work	A task or project that uses such effort.
Charity	Something given to a person or persons in need.
Fundraising	The action or occupation of seeking donated funds for charitable groups, political candidates, and the like.
Spending	To pay out.
Expenses	Money needed to buy or do something; cost.
Donate	To give in order to help a charity or other group.
Volunteer	A person who offers to work or help without pay.

What is a job?

Paid	Full time	Permanent
When someone earns money for the work that they do.	When someone works 35 hours or more each week.	A job without an end date.
Unpaid	Part time	Temporary
When someone doesn't earn money for the work that they do.	When someone usually works less than 35 hours each week.	When someone is hired for a specific amount of time and will often know their end date.

CHARITY
