Mosque	A Mosque is the Islamic place of worship	
Mecca (Makkah)	Is the birthplace of Muhammed. All Muslims face Mecca when they pray	
Ramadan	A holy month for Muslims when they will fast	
Eid-ul-Fitr	A holiday to celebrate the end of Ramadan

Muhammed is the last and most important prophet in Islam




Muslims believe Allah shared the Qu'ran with Muhammed
