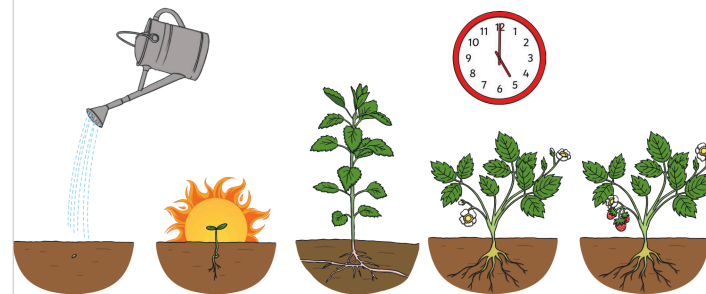
## Key vocabulary

germination	When the conditions are right, the seed soaks up water and swells, and the tiny new plant bursts out of its shell.	
sprout	When a plant sprouts its grows new shoots.	
shoot	A shoot grows upwards from the seed or plant to find sunlight.	
Fruit	Fleshy part of a plant that contains seeds or a stone.	
sunlight	All plants need light from the sun to grow well. Some plants need more or less sunlight depending on their habitat.	
water	All plants need water to grow. Without it seeds and bulbs will not germinate.	
Bulb	A root shaped like an onion that grows into a new plant.	
Seed	Part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant.
