| Muslim | A Muslim is someone who follows Islam |
| Allah | Muslims believe in a God called Allah |
| Tawhid | The belief that there is only one true God - Allah |
| Prophet | Prophets are messengers of Allah who teach people how to live their lives |
| Qu'ran | The Islamic holy book, written in Arabic |
| Mosque | A Mosque is the Islamic place of worship |
| Mecca (Makkah) | Is the birthplace of Muhammed. All Muslims face Mecca when they pray |
| Ramadan | A holy month for Muslims when they will fast |
| Eid-ul-Fitr | A holiday to celebrate the end of Ramadan |
