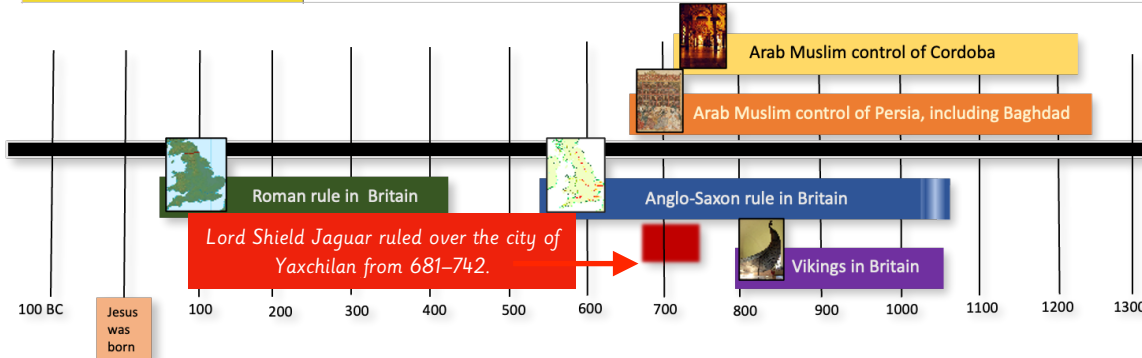

Mayan	Ancient Mesoamerican people with advanced culture.
b'alam	Mayan word meaning "jaguar," often sacred.
Mesoamerica	Region of ancient civilizations like the Maya.
flagstone	Flat stone used for paving surfaces.
adorning	Decorating or adding beauty to something.
Plaza	Open public square in a city or site.
delicacy	A rare and special food item.
Godliest	Most divine or spiritually powerful.
primordial	Ancient or existing from the beginning.
Long count	Mayan calendar system tracking long time spans.
Shaman	A mayan priest, spiritual healer or guide.



Bloodletting in the year 709



Bloodletting was a ritual act of cutting or piercing the skin to offer blood to the gods. It was believed that blood carried spiritual power and was a vital offering to maintain balance in the world.



B'alam is the Maya word for Jaguar. This is the Mayan symbol for B'alam.



The city of Yaxchilan was ruled by the Shield Jaguar in the 7th and 8th Century



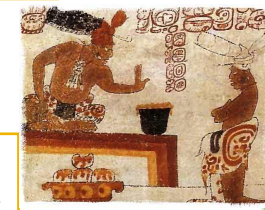

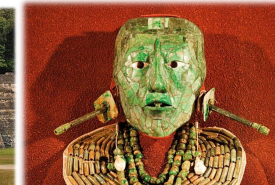
A Mayan ballcourt.



Maize and cacao were an important crop for mayans.

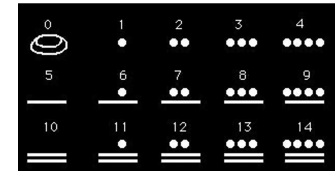
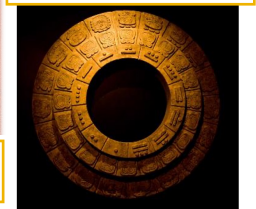


A Mayan temple-pyramid
