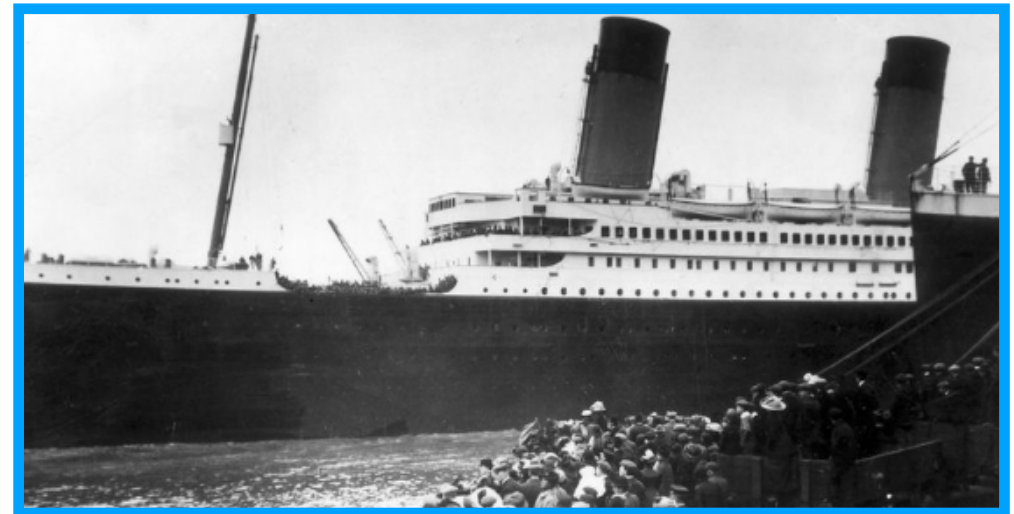
<i>Titanic</i>	<i>The name of the luxury passenger liner that was the largest man-made moveable object ever built.</i>
<i>White Star Line</i>	<i>The company that owned the Titanic.</i>
<i>Southampton</i>	<i>A city in the UK, where the Titanic was launched.</i>
<i>New York</i>	<i>A city in the USA, where the Titanic was headed.</i>
<i>Iceberg</i>	<i>A floating piece of ice.</i>
<i>Voyage</i>	<i>A long journey by land, sea or space.</i>
<i>Passenger</i>	<i>A person who travels on public or private transport.</i>

The Titanic

<i>Number on board</i>	<i>2,223 (1,324 passengers, 885 crew)</i>
<i>Cost</i>	<i>\$7.5 million</i>
<i>Building</i>	<i>Took 3,000 men 3 years to build.</i>
<i>Size</i>	<i>Bigger than three football pitches.</i>

Time of key events

<i>29th July 1908</i>	<i>The design for the Titanic is approved.</i>
<i>31st March 1909</i>	<i>Building on the Titanic begins in Belfast, Ireland.</i>
<i>31st May 1911</i>	<i>The hull of the Titanic is successfully launched.</i>
<i>31st March 1912</i>	<i>The Titanic is completed.</i>
<i>3rd April 1912</i>	<i>The Titanic arrives in Southampton.</i>
<i>10th April 1912</i>	<i>The Titanic begins her maiden voyage.</i>
<i>11th April 1912</i>	<i>The Titanic reaches Queenstown, Ireland.</i>
<i>14th April 1912</i>	<i>The Titanic hits an iceberg. In the early hours of 15th of April the huge ship sinks into the sea.</i>
