



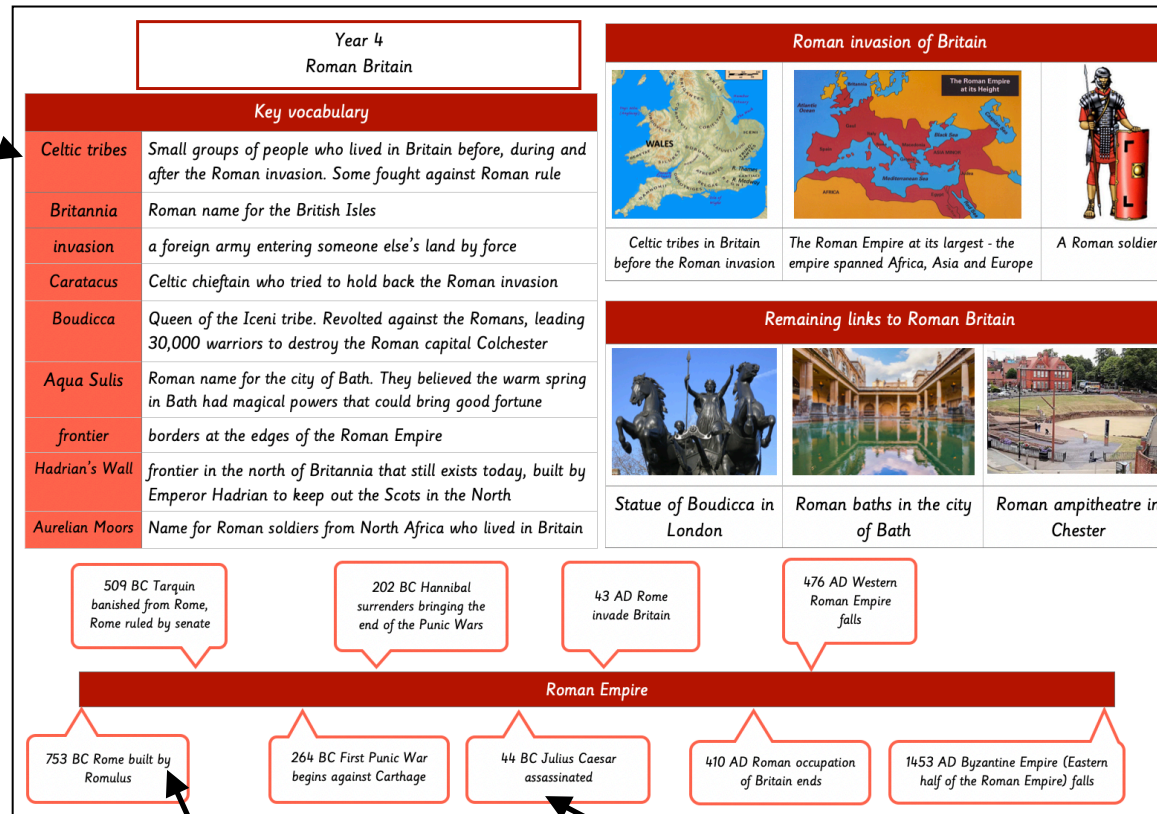
Using Knowledge Organisers (KOs) at home - Parents Guide

Vocabulary check

- Cover the definitions and ask your child to explain them.
- Read the definitions and ask your child to guess the word.
- Ask your child to use the word in a sentence

Top Tips!

- Give children the chance to read/revise the KO regularly
- Recap key learning through discussion before quizzing
- Allow children to share their knowledge with you through writing down everything they have remembered
- See if children can re-create their KO on a blank page



You can cover over some of the **key events** and ask your child to fill in the blanks or explain events.

If there is a **timeline** get children to write the dates in order.

Use the KO to ask children more **challenging questions**. For example;

- Could you make Your own numbers using Roman numerals?
- Can you make a list of countries that the Romans ruled or invaded?

You could ask further questions about the content by asking how or why.
