You can't catch me I'm the Gingerbread Man!	Brr, too cold
Tee hee hee you can't catch me!	never lonely again

Vocabulary – definitions and synonyms

synonyms are words with the same meaning (or almost the same meaning)

scurrying	to move quickly (hurry, rush, dash)
pranced	to move in a lively, happy way (strut, bounce)
frolicked	to act in a playful way (romped, danced)
smirked	to smile in an unkind way (leer, smile, sneer)
churn	a container for milk used to turn it into butter (mixer)
orchard	land where fruit or nut trees grow (farm)
