	Character- A person or an animal in a story.		Setting- Where the story takes place.
	A little bear who lives with a big bear.		At night, in a dark bear cave
	Problem- There is another character or a situation that is a problem for the main character.		How the characters manage to sort out the problem and have a happy ending.
	Little bear can't get to sleep because he is scared of the dark.		After bringing him lanterns, big bear takes little bear outside to look at the moon. He falls asleep in big bear's arms.

### Vocabulary – definitions and synonyms

synonyms are words with the same meaning (or almost the same meaning)

bright	filled with or giving off light (shiny, brilliant, glowing)
dark	having little or no light (black, dim, gloomy)
lantern	a container with a light inside
scared	feeling of fear, being afraid
big	large in size (great, massive, gigantic)
little	Small in size (tiny, wee, miniature)
