


## Year 5 Vector Graphics






In this unit you can use both coding (computer science) and art apps (information technology) to create geometric artwork.

M C Escher Created tesselating/geometric patterns by increasing the complexity of simple geometric shapes. 1898 - 1972 Op Art A form of abstract art that gives the illusion of

movement buy the use of geometry and colour.
