Some of the Parables of Jesus - what is the lesson?

The Unforgiving Servant	The Prodigal Son	Workers of the Vineyard
Matthew 18: 23-24	Luke 15: 11-32	Matthew 20: 1-16
Jesus tells Peter to forgive not 7 times but 77 times. A servant forgiven by the King did not forgive someone so the King put him in jail.	A son asks for all his dad's money and then goes off and wastes it. He runs out of money and comes back, his father welcomes him back.	Vineyard workers are paid the same even though some work longer hours, Jesus teaches if you work or believe you are paid the same.
		

Parables of Jesus about the Kingdom of God

The Treasure Field	The Mustard Seed	The Yeast
Matthew 13:44	Luke 13:18 - 19	Luke 13: 20-21
Jesus compares the Kingdom of God to treasure in a field, if found bury it again but buy the whole field. That way you know it is there.	Jesus teaches about a mustard seed that starts small but grows into a huge plant. The Kingdom of God started small but with Jesus and disciples it grows.	Jesus compares the Kingdom of God to yeast, when added to yeast it rises. This is like the Kingdom of God, rising and growing.
