



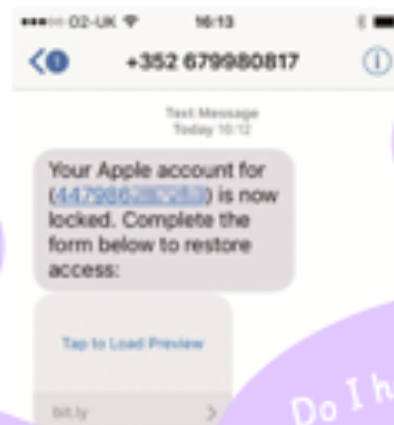
Year 5: Digital Literacy & Citizenship

Key Vocabulary

Reliable	Consistently good in quality or performance; able to be trusted
Spam	Irrelevant or unsolicited messages sent over the internet, typically to a large number of users, for the purposes of advertising, phishing, spreading malware, etc.
Advertising	Messages or photos that are made to persuade someone to buy a certain product
Target	The person who is on the receiving end of the bullying
Risk	Something negative or dangerous that could come from a situation
Private Information	Information that is associated with individuals or groups of individuals, which could reveal details of their lives or other characteristics that could impact them.
Personal Information	Personal information can be almost any information that is associated with an identifiable living individual.
Cyberbullying	Bullying that is done by posting hurtful electronic messages on the internet.
