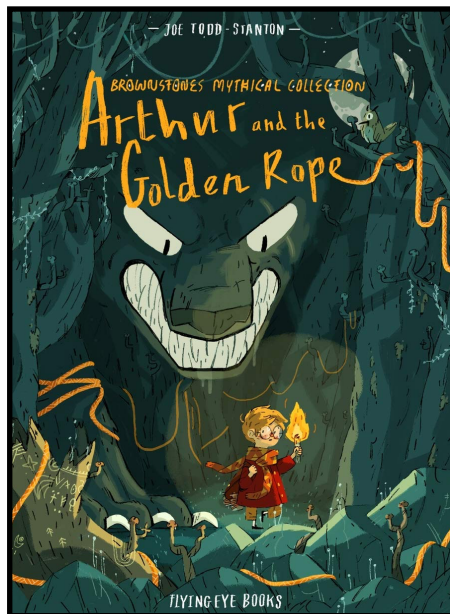


Vocabulary

Grammar, Punctuation and Language Features

noun phrase	determiner + adjective(s) + noun	<i>The beautiful princess.</i>
abstract noun	nouns you cannot see or touch - an idea, concept or quality	<i>love, hate, fear, anger, pride, courage</i>
verbs	an action, doing or being word- they change tense!	<i>running, ran, runs swimming, swims, swam</i>
adverbs	explains how, when or where the verb happens	<i>quickly, fast, immediately, soon</i>
adverbials	a group of words used like an adverb to add detail to a verb (how, when or where)	<i>The story took place some time ago. I'll tidy up in a minute.</i>
fronted adverbial	words/phrases at the beginning of a sentence, used to describe the action that follows (with comma!)	<i>Beside them, All of a sudden, Later that day,</i>
preposition	tell you where a noun is in relation to another noun (the position!)	<i>across, under, above, next to, beside</i>
third person	telling a story when the narrator is an outsider looking in	Using pronouns such as <i>he/she, they/them</i> or <i>it</i>
