### Key Vocabulary

Inappropriate	Not acceptable in the situation; not okay
Red flag feeling	When something happens on digital media that makes you feel uncomfortable, worried, sad, or anxious
Risky	Potentially harmful to one's well-being
Private Information	Information about you that can be used to identify you because it is unique to you (e.g. your full name or your address)
Risk	Something negative or dangerous that could come from a situation
Anonymous	Without a name or other information that identifies who you are
Phishing	When someone poses as an institution, like a bank or school, and sends you a personalised message asking you to provide private information
