### Net Games

#### Key vocabulary

<b>Net</b>	In the middle of a tennis/badminton court is a net that you must hit the ball over. A badminton net is raised off the floor.
<b>Tennis Racket</b>	What we use to play tennis with. The tennis racket allows you to hit the ball, if you use the centre of your racket.
<b>Underarm shot</b>	A shot you make using your racket when it is below your hip and make contact with the ball.
<b>Overhead shot</b>	A shot you make using your racket when it is above your head and make contact with the ball
<b>Badminton Racket</b>	What we use to play badminton with. Very similar to a tennis racket but face of racket is skinnier, whilst handle is longer.
<b>Singles match</b>	A singles match is when one person plays against another person.
<b>Rally</b>	A <b>rally</b> in <b>tennis</b> is a collective name given to a sequence of back and forth shots between players, within a point.
<b>Shuttlecock</b>	Is what we use to play badminton, it is made of feathers.




Badminton Racket
