Jorvik	Viking name for the city of York and the wider Viking kingdom
kinsman	family member
wharves	a platform by a river or the sea where ships can be tied up
vessel	ship or large boat
fragment	a small piece or part of something
stronghold	a place that has been fortified to protect it from attack
assault	strong attack made on an area held by the enemy
Aethelstan	son of Edward raised by Aethelfled, credited with unifying England
consecrated	Something declared sacred or holy
realm	a country, or part of a country, that has its own king or queen
tribute	something you say, do or make to show admiration or respect
King Canute	son of Svein Forkbeard, Canute battled Edmund Ironside for control of England, eventually winning in 1016
