5 types of animal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fish • Amphibians • Reptiles • Birds • Mammals
Fish	goldfish, cod, sharks
Amphibians	frogs, toads, newts
Reptiles	snakes, crocodiles, lizards
Birds	sparrows, chickens, owls
Mammals	humans, dogs, lions
Carnivores	Animals that eat meat e.g. lions and tigers.
Herbivores	Animals that eat plants e.g. cows, sheep and rabbits.
Omnivores	Animals that eat meat and plants e.g. humans, pigs and rats.
Human beings	We are from the family of animals called mammals.

Spelling	Definition/ Sentence
Fish	A cold-blooded animal with a backbone, gills and fins, living in water.
Amphibian	An animal that lives in the water when young or on land as an adult.
Reptile	A cold-blooded egg laying animal with scales.
Bird	An animal with feathers and wings.
Mammal	A warm-blooded animal that has hair or fur, produces milk and gives birth to live young.
Pet	An animal or bird that you keep for pleasure.
