Homework

On a Friday, your child will go home with a Phonics related ELS (Essential Letters and Sounds) reading book, a read for pleasure book and a Phonics newsletter containing a comment sheet on the back. The comment sheet is a type of reading record that you will note down when your child has read at home.

These are all to be kept in your child's book bag so we can read with your child during the week and note down when we have done so on the comment sheet.

We will then change your child's reading books on a Thursday and give new books out on a Friday. This will mean that your child will NOT have school books to read on a Thursday evening. You can simply read for pleasure at home.

A 'Home Learning Journal' book is also sent home. This book is for practising spellings, number bonds etc at home and DOES NOT need to be sent into school.

Spellings, CPG Maths and times tables will be sent home (via Dojo) on a Friday and the children will be tested on these on the following Thursday. Test books with 'results' of tests will be sent home on a Friday as well as new reading books for the following week.

Children are able to bring a healthy snack in for morning playtime - please ensure your child's name is on the snack as children often bring in similar or same snacks. Milk is available—please contact the office if you would like your child to have milk. Children can bring water bottles in and these are stored in table boxes and are readily available. Please ensure water bottles are named.

English

Our core text this term is 'Pumpkin soup' to begin with, followed by 'Perfect plants'.

The children will develop their sentence writing skills, improve their letter formation and begin to use their phonic knowledge to write complete sentences. In grammar, we will be thinking about using capital letters and full stops correctly and using adjectives and simple conjunctions to make our writing interesting.

This term, our reading skills will focus on Vocabulary, inference, predictions, explanations, retrieval and summarising through our stories we are looking at in our Writing sessions.

Maths

In the Summer Term we will continue to develop our understanding of place value by using and rec-organising numbers to 100.

We will continue to develop mastery of number through a variety of practical activities using beads, cubes, Rekenrek and number lines.

We will continue to develop understanding of number bonds up to 20, including the inverse subtractions.
