<u>P.E. DAY</u>

Year 2 P.E. day is Wednesday

The children will attend school in their full PE kit (Plain white round neck T-shirt/ chapel end T-shirt with red sleeves; plain red shorts; plain red sweatshirt/ hoodie/ school jumper or cardigan; plain black jogging bottoms ,trainers suitable for indoor and outdoor physical activity.)

This term our PE units are: Small ball skills, dance, bat and ball skills and Athletics.



Reading homework:

Children thrive on repetition and should be encouraged to listen/ read the same story repeatedly. Reading aloud takes preparation and practise so books should not be read cold. Parents should read the book beforehand and consider: voice(s); pauses; memorable words and phrases; asides and links with the childs own experiences.

The book should be read to the child and then the child should read the book repeatedly themselves. Following reading, talk-time or role play should take place allowing your child to recap events and evaluate/analyse different parts of the text. We only issue each child with one home reading book per week. Children will continue to bring reading books home in their book bag. Please do try and read with your child as regularly as possible and comment in their reading record.

All other homework will be issued on a Friday and a weekly test on spellings and number facts will be completed on the following Thursday. Children will also be asked to complete a page of maths work weekly in their CPG maths booklet. All spellings and number facts homework will be set electronically on Dojo.

Homework activities will support your child's learning in school as they are directly linked to objectives being taught in Reading and Maths in class.

Children are able to bring a **healthy** snack in for morning playtime - please ensure your child's name is on the snack as children often bring in similar or same snacks. Milk is available—please contact the office if you would like your child to have milk. Children can bring water bottles in and these are stored in table boxes and are readily available. Please ensure water bottles are named.


