#### **Welcome to the Autumn term**

Welcome back to school everyone. I am thrilled to be teaching you in Year 5. We are so lucky that Mrs Johnson and Mrs Lavin will also be with us in Year 5. We have so many events/trips/activities to look forward to. I am certain that we will have a great year!

### PE DAY

**Y5** PE day is Tuesday.

The children will attend school in their full PE kit (Plain white round neck T-shirt/ chapel end T-shirt with red sleeves; plain red shorts/skorts; plain red sweatshirt/ hoodie/ school jumper or cardigan; plain black jogging bottoms, trainers suitable for indoor and outdoor physical activity.)

#### PE activities

This term our PE unit is swimming. (Please see information sent separately on Dojo.)



Each week we would ask parents and carers to read every night with their child for at least 10 minutes and make a valuable entry into their child's reading record.

We have no spelling and tables tests this year- instead for spelling we will send home the rule that we have learnt about in class that week along with a practice sheet that can be completed at home. This sheet does not need to be returned to school.

Your child will receive one piece of Maths homework each week that does need to be completed and returned.

Homework is issued on a Friday and returned the following Thursday.

Children will have regular access to a water bottle during the school day—please ensure bottles have your child's name on them and also that it contains still water only. At Chapel End, we encourage healthy snacks and children are able to bring a snack in for morning playtime. Please do try and make these snacks healthy. Milk is available—if you haven't already done so, please contact the office if you wish your child to have milk.

#### **English**

Our novel this term is Journey to the River Sea. We will be using this text in most of our reading and writing lessons

Journey to the River Sea is a wonderful story of adventure into a new world for the main character, Maia. We will initially be using the story to also focus on our Reading domains: Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Summarise (VIPERS). A variety of other texts will also be used to give the children access to a broad range of non-fiction, fiction and poetry texts.

Grammar will initially be taught using Journey to the River Sea as a vehicle as will the majority of our extended pieces of writing which will include an Informal Letter, Setting Description, New Chapter, Balanced Argument and Survival Guide

#### **Maths Units:**

Place Value up to 1 million, Addition/subtraction of 6 digit numbers, Long Multiplication/Long Division, angles, the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, Fractions, Decimals and Percentages, Properties of numbers (Square numbers/cubed/prime numbers etc.)
