This term, our reading skills will focus on Retrieval, Inference, Vocabulary, Summarising, Prediction, Explanation and Sequencing.

Our grammar focus' are the following: Nouns, Expanded Noun Phrases, Determiners, Compound and Complex Sentences including Relative Clauses, Adverbials, Modal Verbs and Prepositions/Prepositional Phrases.

The pieces of extended writing that will be completed are:

- Non Fiction – Informal Letter
- Narrative – Descriptive Writing Part 1 (Positive Description)
- Narrative – Descriptive Writing Part 2 (Negative Description)
- Narrative – A new event/Chapter for our Novel
- Non Fiction – A formal persuasive speech/argument
