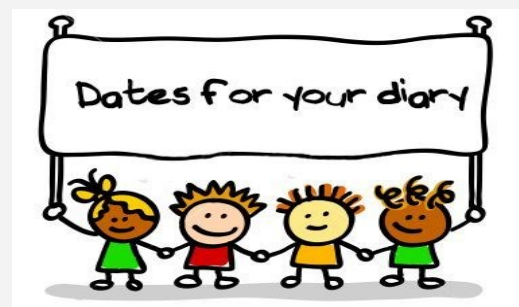

Our whole school topic for the first half of the Summer term is 'Being my best'

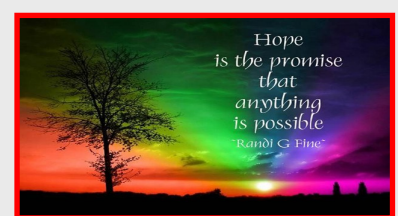
