

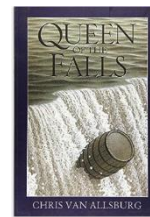


Team 5 - Autumn Home Learning

For example:

$$4 \times 8 = 32$$

$$7 \times 12 = 84$$

It will support your child's Maths to use TTRockstars at least 3 times a week. I will be reviewing their progress and speed regularly.



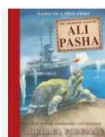
Spelling
