Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

Expressive Arts & Design - Halloween

We will be giving children opportunities to:

- Use different tools and materials to create Halloween themed crafts.
- Sing Halloween songs using a variety of instruments to create effect.

In Maths...

The activities this week will encourage children to look carefully and use the language of comparison to describe sets of objects that they can see, building on the number word we have done so far. Adults will model the language of 'more than' and 'fewer than' to describe how many objects there are in each set. We wil use a range of concrete objects.

In Literacy....

In Literacy this week, we will be starting with discussing and recording our holiday news and giving the children opportunities to talk about their news with their friends. For the rest of the week, we will be reading a story called 'A Magical Muddle' and will be creating our own magic spells for our class spell book. We will finish the week, by creating our own spooky stories using the Mighty Writer.

As part of our class phonics...

During Ready Steady Read, we will be learning the sounds 'j, sh, v, w. We will be learning how to say and write these sounds. We will also be continuing our oral blending practice with 'FRED the frog' and will be using the magnetic boards to help us begin to segment and blend together simple 2 or 3 letter words. Some children will start in new RSR groups, if they are confident sound-blenders.
