


Team 4 Autumn 2 Home Learning

<u>Maths</u>

This half term we will be learning about:

- Using the column method to add and subtract two four-digit numbers.
- How to estimate an answer.
- Developing our recall speed of times tables up to and including the twelve times tables and corresponding division facts.

Time Tables:

This half term we will be learning the following times tables and the corresponding division facts:

2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 10 times tables


For example: 4 x 8 = 32 32 divided by 8 = 4
