Our curriculum learning this week will be focusing on...

PSED - Healthy Teeth

We will be giving children opportunities to:

- To learn about how to keep their teeth healthy

In Maths...

In our focsued maths sessions this week, children will focus on comparing sets and amounts up to 5. We will use the language 'more than', 'fewer than' and 'equal to' to describe what we can see. Children will also continue to build on their 1:1 correspondence skill when comparing. We will play different games to reinforce these skills.

In Literacy....

We will be continuing to reading our new story this week called 'I'm going to eat this ant'. We will find out about the anteater deciding to eat all of the ants in things that begin with a 's'. Adults will be encouraging children to spot the pattern and the initial sounds. During Learning Time, children will be encouraged to play phonics games to hear and identify the initial sounds in foods the anteater likes. We will be working on being able to write these initial sounds too.

As part of our class phonics...

Children will now complete their daily phonics teaching in smaller phonics groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 sounds together and working on our sound-blending skills. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words 1, the. During shared writing we will be focusing on hearing and representing initial and some subsequent sounds.
