Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

Understanding the World — People who help us

We will be giving children opportunities to:

- Discuss the different emergency services.
- To learn about their roles and what they do
- To learn the important number to call if there is an emergency.

In Maths...

In maths this week we will be exploring the how to groups are made up by wholes and parts.

By investigating their own bodies and familiar toys they will begin to understand that whole things are often made up of smaller parts and that a whole is, therefore, bigger than its parts.

In Literacy....

We will be continuing to read our class story this week called 'I'm going to eat this ant'. The ants will visit our classroom this week, leaving lots of words and tricky words behind. We will be focusing on recognising these red tricky words. We will also be focusing on our story-telling skills; ensuring we are able to retell, in order, key events from the story.

As part of our class phonics...

Children will now complete their daily phonics teaching, within different reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 sounds together and working on our oral blending skills. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words I, the, no, of, my, to and spelling these words during shared writing.
