Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

In Maths...

This week in maths children will focus on extending their comparision skills. They will be encouraged to notice when quantities are equal or unequal, and will begin to consider how they can manipulate the number of objects in 2 sets to make them equal. We will reinforce the language of 'more than', 'fewer than' and 'an equal number' to describe how many objects there are in each set.

In Literacy....

This week we will be writing the final parts of the story 'Let's all creep through Crocodile Creek'. We will be using the Mighty Writer resource to help us. Children will be combining all the writing skills they have developed so far, including the using of finger spaces, letter formation and use of their phonics knowledge to spell words and sentences.

As part of our class phonics...

Children complete their daily phonics sessions in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 special friends together and introducing some set 2 sounds, including ay and ee. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words you, my, of During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
