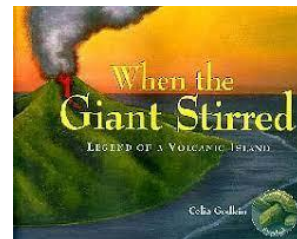


Team 4 Spring 2 Home Learning

Maths

This half term we will be learning about:



- Read, interpret and create a range of graphs.
- Converting time in minutes and seconds
- Converting years to months, weeks and days

Times Tables

This half term we will be learning the following times tables and the corresponding division facts:

6 and 9 times tables.

For example:

$$6 \times 9 = 54$$

$$54 \text{ divided by } 9 = 6$$

It will support your child's maths to use TTRockstars at least 3 times a week. I will be reviewing their progress and speed regularly.



Spelling

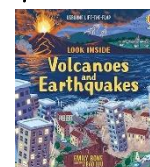
We will be learning the following common exception words from the joint Year3/4 list this half term:
