You will find your child's login in their Reading Records.

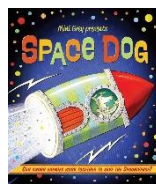

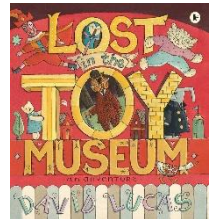

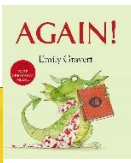
