Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

Understanding the World— Autumn in our Community

## In Maths...

This week, the children will explore how numbers can be composed of 1s and, from this, begin to investigate the composition of 3 and 4. Composing and de-composing numbers involves children investigating part—whole relations, e.g. seeing that 3 can be composed of 1 and 2. The children will learn from practical experience that a 'whole' is made up of smaller parts and is, therefore, bigger than its parts.

## In Literacy....

This week we will be continuing to read the story 'The Gingerbread Man'. Our literacy inputs with provide opportunities to mark make for a purpose, predict and act out the story so far using our small word people and creatures and allow us to identify initial sounds of words when playing different games. Activities during learning time will focus on children using new vocabulary.

## As part of our class phonics...

During Ready Steady Read this week as a class, we will be learning the sounds 'b, f, e, l'. We will be learning how to say and write these sounds. We will also be continuing our oral blending practice with 'FRED the frog' and will be using the magnetic boards to develop our sound-blending skills, to enable us to independently read 2/ letter words.
