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Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

## UTW: The Natural World - Winter

We will be giving children opportunities to:

- Explore the season 'Winter' and discuss features
- Complete a Winter nature walk.
- Link our understanding to the story 'Stickman'.

## In Maths...

This week, the children will use their perceptual subitising skills (seeing the quantity without counting) in increasingly complex arrangements, moving from dots in a line and arrangements of 2, to a focus on standard dice arrangements. We will play different games linked to this skill and ensure children are able to subitise at speed.



## In Literacy....

We will be starting a new text in Literacy the week called 'Let's all Creep through Crocodile Creek'! We will begin the week with a 'hook' to our new text, which includes receiving a very special letter and meeting some new friends. We will explore the word '*journey*' and what it means to go on a journey. Children will share and create our own journeys, applying our phonics skills to our writing.



## As part of our class phonics...

Children will now complete their daily phonics teaching in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 sounds together and working on our oral blending skills. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words **my**, **no**, **said**. During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
