Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

### UTW: Where we live – Polar Regions

We will be giving children opportunities to:

- Explore our world
- Learn to identify the polar regions of our world
- Identify animals that live in the polar regions

### In Maths...

This week, the children will continue to engage with activities that draw attention to the purpose of counting – to find out 'how many' objects there are. The children will also revisit the concept of cardinality – that the last number in the count tells us how many things there are **ALTOGETHER**. They will continue to be provided with opportunities to hear, join in with and develop their knowledge of the counting sequence.



### In Literacy....

We will be continuing to read the next few pages of our class text called 'Let's all Creep through Crocodile Creek'! Children will learn what happens to Rabbit, Mouse and Tortoise as they continue on their journey through the creek. Children will learn to vocabulary including vine, thorn, bumpy and gnarly, and this will be linked to phonic activities during focused task time.



### As part of our class phonics...

Children will now complete their daily phonics teaching in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 sounds together and working on our oral blending skills. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words **said** and **me**. During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
