Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

UTW: Toys from the Past

We will be giving children opportunities to:

- Explore toys from the past
- Compare toys from the past to toys now
- Create their own toys

In Maths...

This week, children will consolidate their understanding of the composition of 5. Composing and decomposing numbers involves the children investigating part-part-whole relations, e.g. seeing that 5 can be made of 3 and 2. The children will deepen their understanding of a 'whole' being made up of smaller parts through practical experience, in this case moving frogs from a log to a pool in a nursery rhyme.



In Literacy....

We will be continuing to read the next few pages of our class text called 'Let's all Creep through Crocodile Creek'!

Children will learn about another animal this week, comparing a tiger to the crocodile from the creek. We will look at some different photographs and videos and discuss what a tiger is like. Children will label an image of tiger using their developing phonic knowledge.



As part of our class phonics...

Children will now complete their daily phonics teaching in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 sounds together and working on our oral blending skills. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words **said, your, to**. During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
