Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

UTW: Our World

We will be giving children opportunities to:

In Maths...

This week, the children will continue to engage with activities that develop their understanding of composition, or the numbers within numbers. A key focus will be on exploring ways to represent numbers using the Hungarian number pattern (die pattern). These key representations will help to underline the '5-ness' of 5, and provide structures that will support exploration of its composition and its relationships with other numbers. The children will secure their understanding of the pairs of numbers that make 5, and then use double dice frames to begin to explore 6 and 7 as numbers that are composed of '5 and a bit'.



In Literacy....

This week we will be finishing the story 'Let's all creep through Crocodile Creep' and will find out what happens to our animal friends at the end. We will explore what a tiger is like and will be writing about their features. Towards the end of the week, we will be re-telling our class story using the Mighty Writer mat and will use actions to help us learn the story.



As part of our class phonics...

Children will now complete their daily phonics teaching in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 sounds together and working on our oral blending skills. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words *my, go, to*. During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
